THE ROBUST BREED

The Danish Yorkshire is one of the parents used in Danish Pig Genetics' crossbreeding program when producing the crossbred Danish Hybrid LY/YL - the other parent being the Danish Landrace.

Originally, the Yorkshire was used because it was seen as a robust animal with strong legs and body posture.

However, the Yorkshire sow very rapidly proved to possess great mothering abilities; and both Yorkshire sows and boars provide excellent results in meat quality, fertility, piglet survival and viability, feed consumption and growth rate.
